Words that sound the same but have different spellings are homophones.



Words that sound the same and have the same spellings are homonyms.

- Bark the sound of dogs/ tree's outer layer
- 3. Band a ring/ a musical group
- 4. Lead to guide someone (to go first with followers )/a type of metal
- 5. Bat an implement used to hit a ball / a nocturnal flying mammal
- 6. Bright very smart or intelligent / filled with light
- 7. Current up to date / flow of water
- 8. Die to cease living / a cube marked with numbers one through six
- 9. Express something done fast / to show your thoughts by using words
- 10. Fair equitable / beautiful
