



GRAMMAR TENSES









Present tense

- Present simple: We use the present simple when something is always true or habits/ things that we do regularly.
- The sun <u>rises</u> in the east It <u>snows</u> in winter here.
- I play tennis every Tuesday.
- Intermediate students write exams in the month of march.
- Present continuous: we use the present continuous for things that are happening at the moment of speaking. These things usually last for quite a short time.
- I'm working at the moment.
- Look! The birds are flying.
- Mary is writing a letter now.
- She is staying with her friend for a week.
- Present perfect: We use this tense when we want to talk about unfinished actions or states or habits that started in the past and continue to the present.
 - The window looks damaged ,someone has broken it .
 - Ravi is in the hospital, he <u>has met</u> with an accident.
 - she cannot play tennis, she has injured her leg.

- Present perfect continuous : action which started in the past and continue to the present.
- She has been working here since 2004.
- I have been living in London for two years.
- The boys have been playing football match since morning.
- My son has been playing video game since yesterday.

Past tense

- Past simple: We use the past simple when something has already been done in the past.
 - I went to market yesterday.
 - My brother visited US last year.
 - We wrote our internals last month
- Past continuous :we use the past continuous for an action in the past which overlaps another action.
 - I was walking to the station when I met John.
 - I was eating my breakfast when the door bell rang.
 - The children were sleeping when the guest arrived.
- Past perfect : A finished action before a second action that took place in the past.
 - When we arrived, the film <u>had started</u> .(first the film started, then we arrived)
 - It <u>had snowed</u> in the night, so the bus did not arrive.
 - She would have passed the exam if she had studied harder.
- Present perfect continuous: Used to denote an action that began before a certain point in the past and continued up to some time in past.
 - In the year 1998 I had been learning English in this school for 20 days. Last week The boys had been playing football match since two days.

Future tense

- Future simple: This tense tells us about an action which has not occurred yet and will occur in future
 - I will go to market tomorrow.
 - My brother shall visit US next year. We will write our internals next month.
- Future Continuous: It is used to express an ongoing or continued action in future.
 - At this time tomorrow, he will be distributing sweets.
 - Tomorrow by this time we shall be going to our excursion.
